Best-selling author Terry Fallis debuts new book at the County of Brant Public Library

Fallis will discuss his highly anticipated new novel, *The Marionette*, and join CBPL's Emma Johnston in conversation about his writing process, literary career, and previous bestselling titles.

Fallis is a two-time winner of the Stephen Leacock Medal for Humour, best known for his debut novel *The Best Laid Plans*, which also won the 2011 CBC Canada Reads competition. His work is celebrated for its wit, warmth, and insight into the human condition. His latest release, *The Marionette*, is described as a comic thriller that follows successful action novelist James Norval, whose life takes a dramatic turn when a series of unfortunate events lands him in an undercover mission to infiltrate the Malian government.
